

March-April 2020: Stakeholder survey (163 participants)

April-August 2020: Independent evaluation; June- inputs for SP 2021-2025

June-July 2020: Review of relevant mechanisms' activities, and regional &

global context of NEASPEC work

July 2020: Circulation of background document and draft SP 2021-2025

August 2020: National Focal Points meeting on the SP 2021-2025; and

additional feedback

Key Considerations for the Programmatic Areas

- Promote the interlinkage and synergies among the programmatic areas
- Enhance the interlinkage of the NEASPEC work with member States' commitments to regional and global goals (e.g. National LEDS under the Paris Agreement, Post-2020 Global Biodiversity Framework, ESCAP resolutions on air pollution and oceans, etc.)
- Contribute to the achievement of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, particularly environment-related SDGs
- Provide room for identifying other emerging issues of mutual interests among member States

- Progress in domestic policies and outcomes
- Gaps in achieving national standards/global commitments
- NEASPEC: platform for exchanging information and knowledge, and mobilizing joint action



- Overall Goals and Approaches
- Objectives and Activities in each programmatic area



- Institutional support through SOM, Secretariat, Committees/WGs, Financial Resources
- Monitoring and evaluation
