# Black-faced Spoonbills (1)

- (Breeding ground in ROK) Securing tidal-flats and rice-paddies as foraging sites of spoonbills -> **NEASPEC Public Awareness programme on tidal-flat and rice paddies (?); Joint Study on NEASPEC Korean DMZ area (Continued)**
- (Breeding ground in DPRK) Need more survey to west costal areas, potential breeding sites -> **NEASPEC Joint Study or Support Programme (?)**

# Hooded Cranes

- (Common in NEA) Securing more alternative wintering sites in NEA -> **How we develop this idea into NEASPEC action?**
- (Common in NEA, suggested by ROK) Joint study to compare habitat ecology and management planning among Cheonsu bay, Suncheon bay, Chongmingdongtan, Izmui and Yashiro

# White-naped Cranes (1)

- (Staging sites) 2 sites in Mongolia gathering birds together especially in every September -> **NEASPEC Joint Simultaneous census**
- (Common in NEA, suggested by Mongolia) Establishing data-hub Sharing data -> **Need NEASPEC Key Migratory Birds' data base system?**
- (Common in NEA) **NEA Crane Environmental Education Camp**
- (Wintering ground in Korea) Cheorwon need to develop the local SD plan -> **1)NEASPEC Sustainable Crane Tourism in Cheorwon and DMZ area including NEA Crane Festival; 2) Joint Study on NEASPEC Korean DMZ area (Continued)**






# CEPA and Capacity Building Programme in Common
