Annotated Provisional Agenda

1. Opening of the meeting

The meeting will begin with opening and welcoming address, followed by the introduction of members from the Science and Policy Committee (SPC) and Technical Centers (TCs).

2. Election of officers

The meeting will elect a chair and a vice-chair prescribed by the Rules of the Procedure¹ for the NEACAP Science and Policy Committee, which require the election of these officers at the commencement of each meeting, with their terms concluding at the subsequent regular meeting.

3. Adoption of agenda

The provisional agenda will be reviewed and adopted by the meeting, subject to changes as deemed necessary.

4. Review of the implementation of the NEACAP Activity Plan 2025

The meeting will review the progress of the remaining NEACAP activities in 2025, including those to be held in conjunction with the 28th Senior Officials Meeting (SOM-28) of the North-East Asian Subregional Programme for Environmental Cooperation (NEASPEC). The review and discussions will be based on the secretariat's presentation.

5. Discussion on the draft NEACAP Work Plan 2026-2030
